



ATTENTION:

Radiology, Nuclear Medicine and Radiation Therapy Graduates:

Upon graduation from your imaging program, in order to work in the field of imaging in the State of Arkansas, you will need to have applied for a Temporary License with the Arkansas Department of Health. Temporary Licensure Applications may be printed from the ADH/Radiologic Technology Licensure Program **Forms Page** located at www.healthy.arkansas.gov/rtl .

Once you have passed your national registry/certification and received your ARRT or NMTCB certification by mail;

1. Please make a copy of your ARRT or NMTCB card, write your employer information (address and contact numbers) on the sheet on which you have copied your ARRT card.
2. Please fax this information **to: (501) 661-2236**. Upon receipt of the copy of your ARRT or NMTCB card, we will transfer your Temporary License to a Radiologic Technologist License in Radiography, Radiation Therapy or Nuclear Medicine respectively, and we will mail your ADH/RTL certificate to the address that you provided on your Temporary License application. Please provide change of address information to your fax if your address has changed.

If your Temporary License has not yet expired, there will be no Licensure fee due at this time. When you receive your renewal invoice one year from issuance of your Radiologic Technologist License, you will pay your licensure fee at that time and you will need to provide a current copy of your ARRT or NMTCB card. The copy of your current ARRT or NMTCB card which should read, "Within CE Compliance" will serve as proof of continuing education. The CEU that you will earn to keep your ARRT or NMTCB registry/certification compliant, may also serve as evidence of Continuing Education for ADH/RTL State Licensure.
